Rogers –In helping with Officer groups and training in the region or for departments, Thompson suggested a "Shift Commanders Luncheon" and that was something done in the past with some success.

Regional Gear PPE Spec. is coming up for bid. They are looking at several companies; Innotex, Lion, Glove, FireDex. Etc... Information as it comes in. Contact Rogers Training Dept. for more information.

Lowell – Concerned with current NWACC Paramedic Program as many of the students have given complaints, not known if formal, about the lack of supervision, instruction, and the lack of overall quality of the program. This seems to be directly related to this program as the COVID-19 pandemic has affected in-class schedules. Rogers – Thompson talked about a 10-week online Paramedic program through the State of Texas for potential alternatives.

Tonitown – Volunteer Base Recruitment Strategy – The will serve as an area Recruitment Department for local departments within a 50-mile area. They have current funding to send anyone who applies through them, to FF 1&2 and EMT training free of charge as long as they meet residency requirements, and then they are welcome to go to any paid department afterwards. There are simple time requirements and after one year, there is no other obligation. This is all provided through grant funding for another 3.5 years. Send applicants who need training their way.
